A BRIEF HISTORY OF NOTRE DAME COLLEGE OZORO

In 1956 HRM Orokpokpor Egware II the Ovie of Ozoro kingdom had a meeting with the Bishop of the Catholic Dioceses of Benin (Bishop Patrick Joseph Kelly) on the need to open a secondary school in Ozoro where the Church mission society was very strong. The Bishop gave his consent and support as he sees it as a means of evangelizing. HRM Orokpokpor Egware II set out for Ibadan to meet with the Minister of Education Stephen Oluwole Awokoya on the need to open a secondary school in Ozoro. A move that was totally rejected by the minister giving reason that a school has already been approved for Isoko by the then Western Region government for Isoko people hence they cannot open or fund two schools at the same time for Isoko. This decision was not pleasing to the traditional ruler who then took his case to Chief Obafemi Awolowo, the Premier of the western Region.

HRM Orokpokpor Egware II categorically told Chief Obafemi Awolowo that if the school is not approved for Ozoro, the premier should be ready to loose Ozoro votes as he is ready to approach Chief Nnamdi Azikiwe who will be willing to establish a secondary school in Ozoro. Chief Obafemi Awolowo upon hearing that, immediately gave a directive to the education minister for approval of the establishment of the school as a mission school.

Notre Dame College Ozoro took off as a Catholic School on the 9th day of March in the year of our Lord 1957 and it rained cats and dogs on that Saturday. It became the second grammar school founded in Isoko land. The Ovie of Ozoro, Orokpokpor Egware II gave out his storey building along Idheze road, in Erovie quarters that served as the only temporary building to enable the school start. The pioneer students and staff later moved into the present site donated by the Ozoro community.

The Catholic Mission remained the owner of the school until August 1973 when all voluntary agency schools in the then Midwest state were taken over by government. As a result of that exercise the school remained a public school from 1973 to 2012.

In the year 2001 the college was renovated, fully equipped and upgraded to a model school with nineteen other secondary schools in the state by Chief James Onanefe Ibori's Government.

In 2011, the Delta state government under the leadership of Dr. Emmanuel Eweta Uduaghan announced the return of forty (40) public schools that were originally established by voluntary agencies and religious bodies to their original owners. Upon the return of the school to the Catholic mission, the school was turned into a mixed secondary school - a decision that has not gone down well with old boys of the school.

Since its establishment, the college has passed through the administration of twenty principals and has changed school uniform thrice. The school has produced Senators, members of the federal House of Representatives, states houses of assemblies, chairmen of local government areas, professors, medical doctors, engineers, pilots, sailors, Bishops, Rev. Frs., and numerous clergy men, educationists and academicians, publishers, movies directors and producers, Business tycoons, high ranking military men, great sports men, Legal luminaries, Journalists, architects, directors and chairman of various companies, community leaders, the list is endless.

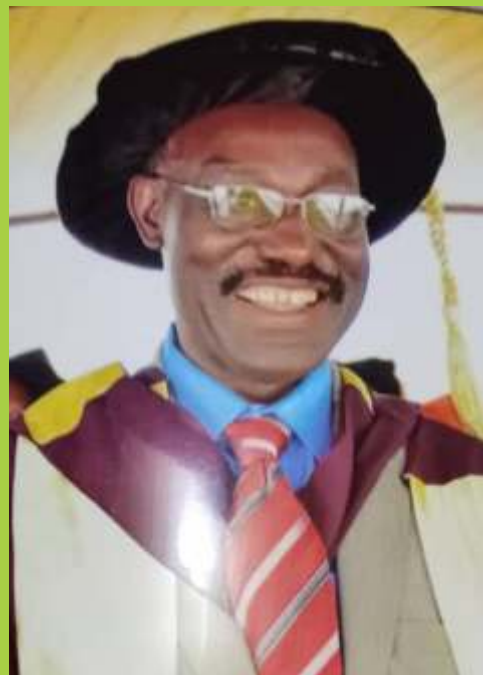

NOTRE DAME COLLEGE, OZORO (OLD BOY'S ASSOCIATION) BRIEF HISTORY

The First Association of Old Boys' of Notre Dame College, Ozoro was in 1965 under the leadership of Mr. Francis Ogeh. After the inaugural meeting nothing was of this association. In 1976 an Old Boy who was then Medical Officer of the General Hospital, Owhelogbo, initiated yet another association it was far as old boys from all over the country came and spent the weekend in one of the hostels. This association went into oblivion some years later.

In 1984, the same Old Boy, undaunted by the collapse of the various attempt of formation of a viable association, initiated yet another grouping. Senator Francis Spanner Okpozo was elected president. Every Old Boy heaved a sigh of relief, that at last a viable NODACOBAs was formed.

On 3rd December, 1988, a 5- member National Caretaker Committee was inaugurated. The members were:

- (2) Mr. F.O Ootobo – Secretary
- (3) Mr. Emma A. Emakporuena
- (4) Mr. Ogaga Obaro and
- (5) Barr. A. Oghenejabor,

The caretaker committee had one year to complete her assignment. Unfortunately this did not come to be. The reason was that all concerned National Convention did not hold because quorum was not formed.

However, with the able intervention of some compatriot Dr. O.E. Esieke, Mr. P.E Ajobo, Dr. C. Edema, Dr. R.S. Onoruvie, Engr. E.N. Kragha et al, a National Convention was held on 19th April 1997.

At the convention a crop of dedicated Old Boys were elected. They are:

This Executive Council continued to pilot the affairs of the Association in spite of the pall of problems facing the Association, obvious among these are finance and non-attendance at National Convention. These executives lasted from 19th April, 1997 – March 18, 2016. On the 19th of March 2016, a national convention/Founder's day celebration and fund raising ceremony took place at the school premises where the association constitution was ratified and a new executive was inaugurated.

OLD BOYS SHARE THEIR SCHOOL DAYS EXPERIENCES

MY DAYS AT NDC from Dr. Michael Okogbo

1. After I finished from Notre Dame College, Ozoro in December 1965, I did my HSC at the Federal Government College Warri 1966-1967; we were the pioneer students of that institution. I taught in Notre Dame College, Ozoro from January 1968 to September, 1969. I taught Physics and Biology in the senior classes but do not recall what I taught in the junior classes. I proceeded to the University of Lagos College of Medicine in September 1969 and got the MB,BS in June 1974.

After housemanship and NYSC, I was back again to familiar grounds but this time to Oleh as Medical Officer of Health 1976 to 1978.

By June 1978 I started my training in Pediatrics at the University College Hospital, Ibadan. Part of my training took me to Mc Gill University in Montreal Canada, where I took a subspecialty training in Pediatric Neurology, 1983-1984.

After my training, for which I was awarded the FMCPaed by the Nigerian Postgraduate Medical College, I joined the Kano State Government in 1986 as Consultant Pediatrician and rose to Senior Consultant before I left service to start my practice in 1990.

I relocated to the USA in 1995. After further training in pediatrics, and certified by the American Board of Pediatrics, I joined a private practice group in Amarillo, Texas. Along the way, I did an MBA program in Health Organizational Management at Texas Tech University, Lubbock.

Thereafter I taught in 2 medical schools, Texas Tech School of Medicine, Amarillo and Texas A&M College of Medicine, Temple, Texas. I retired as Associate Professor of Pediatrics from Texas A&M in 2015.

I am currently medical director and co-founder of Northside Pediatrics Associates, Conroe, in the Houston area, Texas.

2. I gained admission into NDC in 1961. Notre Dame was the school I passed entrance to. Interestingly, apart from one person who later became an engineer, all my peers from the elementary school who went to other schools, had higher aggregate than I had. Recall that the lower the aggregate the better. Notre Dame must have been doing something right.

3. Rev Fr. O'Shea was the Principal when I entered and Mr Patrick Agokei was Principal at the year I left.

4. What I recall in my years in NDC I wrote up at the 50th Anniversary Celebration. Please check We are NODACO in the brochure for the occasion.

5. There are several of them I recall and am in contact with some. Olorogun Atuyota Ejughemre, Dr Gabriel Atiri, Tony 'Gbesono' Emumejaye, Patrick Odiri Ojuederie, Dr Tony Akpoborie, Christopher Abada, Charles Okonkwo, Philip Ezeli, Diamond Ovueraye, Sunny Joe, Sunday Omagbemi and Emmanuel Judo. One classmate I remember always, who would have done Notre Dame proud had he lived long enough is the inimitable Silas Egenti.

He was killed during the civil war, one week to the end of the war! And how can I not remember late CP Jonah Ekama.

6. How did Notre Dame change or influence my life? Simple. Notre gave us a foundation in character and learning. Whatever we all became was built on that foundation.



7. This is work in progress.

8. We have to continue to support NDC in all ways within the means at our disposal.

9. Yes, I am aware and I belong to the North America branch.

10. I must say I was quite opposed to this but I have been thinking about this again lately. Are we trying to keep ourselves trapped in the past? If NDC is good for our sons, why won't it be good for our daughters? Should a co-educational NDC become a resounding success, other schools would begin to adopt the NDC model. The argument that we did not attend a co-ed school is specious because there are many things in our early life we did/did not do, that would not apply now. Does a co-educational NDC reduce our prestige among our peers? Certainly not.

These issues aside, there are benefits, educationists would confirm that these children get by schooling together. I do not see the downside of a co-ed school. I stand to be corrected. So let the debate continue.

My Days at NDC from EUGENE OBOH

My name is Eugene O Oboh. I was at Notre Dame College, Ozoro-Delta state, Nigeria from January 1971 to June 1975. I am a Chemistry graduate from the University of Calabar, Nigeria (1976-1980). Currently I reside in the United States of America working as a Chemist in a chemical industry.

I was admitted to class one on January, 1971. My parents probably wanted me at Notre Dame College to familiarize myself with the culture of my tribe-Isoko, since I had my primary school education in Ibadan and I was in Lagos before I came to Ozoro.

Rev. Father H Jones was the Principal of the school at my admission up till class three while Mr. Edwin O Oruma was the school's Principal at the end of 1973 to my exit-1975. 1973 was the year the schools' calendar in Nigeria was changed from January through December to September through June.

Recollecting my years in NDC is like asking me to write a book. I will always give glory to God who saw me through my years at the school and through all my journeys to and fro Lagos where I spent most of my holidays. By the grace of God I can conveniently say I top my class all my years at NDC since I missed FIRST position in class, twice. There were days of joy and there were days of sorrow. There were days of happiness and there were days of anguish. The period of my class two was full of anguish. Like I said God helped me academically so I earned the prestigious Bendel state Academic Scholarship in my first term of class two in 1972. Tuition and boarding always fully paid for, by the government. "This is the preliminary stage of a tyrannical



government”. This statement was made by a Prefect of a 1972 sect after the 1971 sect have left. It was a very dreadful regime. A lot of calamities/disasters occurred in that year. We must be very careful of what we say. Punishment is meant to correct and discipline and not an act of cruelty and pride due to seniority in class. I believe it was all out of ignorance because people did not understand what life was all about. Even though my tuition and boarding was fully paid for by the government I told my parents I wanted to be an off campus student (Day Student). It was bad! Serious injuries and deaths were recorded at schools (though no death was recorded at NDC). The National President of Old Boys' Association is my classmate and a host of others, though some are no more living on earth today. There is no need listing their names but I am in touch with some of them.

It would not have been easy for me to have a University degree without having my School certificate from NDC. During the first three years of Rev. Father Jones there were qualified Teachers on School while in my classes four and five period there were more of unqualified Teachers. I got my admission to the University through Concessional exam in 1976 before JAMB started in 1978. At the University of Calabar, 1976-1980 I was in same class with my class five teacher. This will tell you the level of our Teachers, then. The cruel discipline only instilled fears/hatred on people.

I have not actually given anything back because I was angry with the whole system. I may be wrong but I think my sect-1975 was the only sect that has their certificates/testimonials with the name “Ozoro Grammar School”. James Welsh Grammar School's Old Boys' Association was able to stand against changing the name of their school to Emevor Grammar School. Why couldn't our Old Boys do same? However, the Old Boys made me proud when I saw about fifteen of them at my father's funeral in Ibrede in June this year. I did not even know there was a Union called DNC Old Boys so I did not invite them. That action of the Old Boys has changed my thinking towards my Alma Mater.

The purpose of belonging to a Union is for development. As we focus on developing the school we must also focus on helping one another. We will never think alike but let's be our brothers' keepers. Life is short. “A tree cannot make a forest”. When we are well positioned financially the burden will be lighter. There should be no selfishness and self-centeredness.

I am aware of the association. I'm not sure of any student around where I am located but I will see if there is any union somewhere around me.

Like I said we will never think alike. I strongly oppose NDC being a co-educational school. Let it remain only Boys school.
